

MASTER OF ARTS IN SANSKRIT (2-YEAR) (PREVIOUS)

Eligibility Conditions

Pass in Bachelor's Degree examination with the subject as Sanskrit in all three parts OR Shastri (Vishishta with English) of Kurukshetra University OR of any other recognized University, provide that candidates must have passed the subject of Sanskrit (compulsory or elective) at Degree level.

MASTER OF ARTS IN SANSKRIT (2-YEAR) (FINAL)

Eligibility Conditions

Pass in Part-I/Previous of the relevant programme from Kurukshetra University. Provided that a candidate who has to re-appear in not more than 50% Papers of Part-I shall also be eligible for provisional admission to Final/Part- II Class of the relevant programme, subject to passing the remaining paper(s) of part-I in the permissible number of chances.

NOTE: The candidates shall be required to pass both the parts of the programme within a maximum period of four years from the session of their admission to the concerned programme in Previous/Part-I.
